CHRIST KING HR. SEC. SCHOOL, KOHIMA PROSPECTUS 2020-2021 ARTS STREAM

Christ King Hr. Sec. School was founded in 1969. The school is officially recognized by the Nagaland Board of School Education. It was upgraded into Higher Secondary in 2005. The school with its motto: "To Lead and To Share" has moulded several young minds into leaders capable of sharing their wisdom and knowledge.

1. Scheme of Studies for Class XI and Class XII

The scheme of studies and subjects for Class XI and XII shall be as prescribed by the Nagaland Board of School Education Kohima. The subjects are as follows:

- I. English
- II. Four elective subjects can be chosen from the following:
 - a. Alternative English or Tenyidie
 - b. History
 - c. Political Science
 - d. Education
 - e. Sociology

III. Fifth Elective Subject:

The Fifth Elective Subject has to be either Education or Sociology. The rank of a successful candidate shall be decided on the basis of best 5 (five) subjects.

IV. Internally assessed subjects:

- a. Environmental Education
- b. Work & Art Education
- c. Physical and Health Education
- d. Religion and Values

2. Scheme of Examinations

2.1 Nature of Examination

The pattern of Higher Secondary Examinations shall be as follows:-

(A) Class XI

The date and time of the examination will be fixed by the Board. The question papers for the promotion exam will be given by the board. The Evaluation and the provisional result will be prepared by the institution. The result will be approved and counter signed by the Controller of Examination (NBSE) before it is declared by the institution. The successful candidates of Class XI promotion examination will be given Pass Certificate by the NBSE after the declaration of the results.

(B) Class XII

Selection for Higher Secondary School Leaving Certificate will be determined on the basis of the student's total record of performance in the academic year. The Principal's decision in this regard will be final and binding.

The Board shall conduct the Class XII Examination. The examination shall be based on the syllabus for Class XII.

2.2 Pass Criteria and Classification of successful candidates:

- i) 33 marks in subject having 100 external marks
- ii) 30 marks and 3 marks separately in subject having 90 external and 10 internal/project work
- iii) For promotion to the next higher class, a candidate must pass in 5(five) subjects which includes the compulsory subjects.

- iv) Classification of result:
 - a) III Division 165 to 224.
 - b) II Division 225 to 299.
 - c) I Division 300 and above.

3. Minimum attendance of classes required:

A student pursuing a regular course must have 80% or above class attendance to his/her credit in order to sit for the promotion examination. It is compulsory for a student to appear for the periodic tests conducted by the school.

4. Change of Subject:

No candidate shall be allowed to change his/her subject after passing class XI.

5. **ADMISSION**: (Please pay special attention to this section)

- a. Application forms will be available online after the Matric results are declared by NBSE. A candidate must read the instructions carefully before filling the form. All incomplete filling and non-submission of required documents will be rejected.
- b. As per the notification from NBSE the academic session of Class XI will start at the direction of the Government of Nagaland, or within 20 days of the declaration of HSLC results as earlier if situation is normalized.
- c. Those who secure 60% and above in the external will be given direct admission. There is no assurance that all those who have submitted application will be selected for class XI. Those who have been selected for admission to Cl. XI will receive a notification in your email. Then you may go to Vijaya Bank (Now **Bank of Baroda**) near Razü Point. Admission will be closed when sufficient numbers of students are admitted.
- d. If selected and admitted, the following certificates are to be submitted at the time of resumption of class:
 - i) 3 attested copies of HSLC mark sheet + original
 - ii) 3 attested copies of HSLC admit card + original
 - iii) 5 copies of passport size photo (black & white)
 - iv) Cumulative record
- c. The principal's decision with regard to admission will be final and binding.
- d. Normally, only the successful students of current year HSLC Examination will be admitted for Class XI.
- E. In general no candidate will be admitted in Class XII.

6. Fees:

All students irrespective of admission date, shall pay 12 (twelve) months tuition fees at the rate of 700/-per month.

You may pay your Admission and tuition fees at Bank of Baroda (*Vijaya Bank near Razü point*), Kohima. When you are selected for admission, your name and fee coupon will be available at the bank.

7. Uniform & Books:

Boys - Dark Navy Blue Pant, Blazer, Belt, Tie, Socks, Black shoes, (Price of 2 shirts, 1 pant, tie, blazer & waist coat = `2,800/-).

Girls - Dark Navy Blue Pant, Blazer, Belt, Tie, socks, Black shoes, (Price of 2 shirts, 1 Pant, tie, blazer & waist coat = 2,800/-).

Note: Uniform money has to be paid on the day notified by the school (The School uniform is compulsory on all working days.

Tracksuit & School T. shirt will be worn on Wednesday & Saturday. Text Books & Note Books should be bought from the school.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- 1. Students who are not successful in Class XI Promotion Examination will forfeit their stay at Christ King Hr. Secondary School.
- 2. After the Admission/Readmission has been taken in the School, no refund will be made if the student does not want to continue in the institution. Fees once paid are not refundable.
